Laundry

We have coin-operated washing machines and dryer. Washing machines take $4x\$ 1 coins and the dryer takes $2x\$ 2 coins. Change and laundry powder is available to purchase at the kiosk. There is an iron and ironing board for guest use in the laundry/camp kitchen. Please empty the machines when the cycle is complete and remove dry clothes from the clothes' line. Please do not wash dishes in the laundry tub – or clothes in the kitchen sink.

Noise

Quiet time is between 9pm and 7am. Consider your neighbours by keeping the volume down on radios, TV and social gatherings. Excessive noise or offensive language will not be tolerated and can result in guests or visitors being asked to leave immediately.

Pets

We are a pet-friendly park. Pets are permitted on all powered and non-powered sites, and in cabins – with conditions. Dogs must be leashed at all times within the general park area and are not permitted in the camp kitchen or amenity block for hygiene reasons (except service dogs). We have unfenced off-leash areas with adjoining walking trail and pet poop bags can be found at every bin point. Towels for pet use are available from the office.

Security

We'd like your stay to be enjoyable. We suggest that you get to know your neighbours and keep an eye out for each others' belongings. Please keep your possessions, vehicles and accommodation safely secured at all times. We accept no responsibility for your belongings, vehicles or pets. Some security lighting remains on in the park at night.

Sunrise Viewpoint

Our Sunrise viewpoint is located at the top of the Park, overlooking the top tier camping area .It's a purpose-built "Big Picture Frame" and seat, made from locally sourced scribbly gum wood and showcasing a stunning view of Mt Larcom and surrounding range. Vehicles



Activities

Air-conditioning

In order to save energy and to keep our prices competitive please turn off the air-conditioning when you leave your cabin. If you are returning later in the day please send Del an SMS (0413411924) and your air-con can be turned on ahead for your comfort on arrival.

Amenities

Please refer to the site map for the location of the amenity building. Please consider others and limit showers to help conserve water. The amenity block is cleaned daily and may be closed at that time. We have a septic system and request that **only toilet tissue and body waste be** flushed. All sanitary aids, nappies and moist wipes should be wrapped and placed in the bins provided. **Children** under 10years must be supervised by an adult.

Bikes, ride-on equipment and motorised toys

For the safety and enjoyment of all guests, only standard bikes and scooters are to be ridden in the park. Road rules are to be observed, and a safety helmet must be worn at all times, as required by QLD law.

Boom Gates

Entry gate is key-coded - please keep your code safe. Exit gate is automatic - please approach the gate square on and the gate will lift automatically.

Cabins

Please report all damages, breakages or losses to Kev or Del promptly. If you think something that should be provided has been omitted, please ask so that this can be rectified. Spare blankets are placed in drawers/cupboards depending on room type. Please leave the cabin clean and tidy, dishes washed, dried and put away, and rubbish placed in bins provided. Additional cleaning charges and full replacement cost may apply where furniture is not left as originally found or the condition of the cabin on departure is unacceptable. Guests are responsible for the safe-keeping and replacement of lost keys.

Camp kitchen and BBQ

Please respect others and clean up after use. If the BBQ needs gas replaced, please ask – do not change the bottles. Alcohol and medications are prohibited in the camp fridge. The camp kitchen is a smokefree and pet-free zone. Stubby coolers for guest use can be found in the cupboard beside the BBQ – please return after use.

Corona/Covid 19 virus precautions

Please heed all notices and information displayed within the park and cabins. This is for ALL guest and staff safety. The signs are updated regularly to meet current restrictions.

Check-in Time/Check-out time

Sites – 11am to 6pm Cabins – 2pm to 7pm

THERE IS NO LATE CHECK_IN AVAILABLE FOR SITES _ THE CAMPGROUND CLOSES STRICTLY AT ^PM. Late check-in for cabins between 7pm and 10pm must be pre-arranged. NO LATE CHECK-IN AVAILABLE AFTER 10pm.

All sites and cabins check-out 10am please

Late check-outs depend on availability – please ask. Early departures (before 7am) please leave your key inside the cabin.

Chemical dump point

There is no chemical dump point in the park – please do not dump your toilet/cassette waste in our toilets as septics are expensive to repair and doing so is malicious damage and an offence. The nearest public dump point is 32k south at Calliope.

Children

Supervising children is vital for their safety and ensures they do not disturb other guests. Children must be accompanied by an adult when visiting the park amenities and all other park facilities.

Evacuation Procedure

In an emergency follow the directions of staff. If we need to evacuate please make your way directly to the Evacuation Assembly Point located on the front lawn in front of the BBQ. See notices in the camp kitchen/cabins.

Fees and Discounts

Must be paid in full in advance. We have EFTPOS/PayPal/Visa/Mastercard and cash payment options. Kui Park and CMCA members receive 10% member discount on the presentation of proof of membership. APOD/ADF 20% on sites, 15% on cabins. Ask about joining here for immediate discount on your stay.



Fires

Only our Park camp fire-pits may be used for fires. This is for your safety and the preservation of our garden setting. Please douse fires with water after use.

Garbage/Litter

Please help us to care for our environment by using the rubbish and recycling bins located throughout the park for your convenience. 10c refundable bottles and cans are collected in the small bins.

Gas refills

We have a swap n go service in the Park - all sizes \$27. Refills are available from the Feed Shed across the road from our exit.

Grey water

Caravan grey water may be drained directly via your hose onto the park gardens and lawns. We have a grey water recovery system that drains via sprinkler onto the front lawns – beware as it comes on randomly!

Guests and Visitors

All guests and their visitors, and any visitor to the Park who intends to exit their vehicle or enters by foot/bicycle **MUST NOT ENTER THE PARK** without signing a visitor form/Covid 19 declaration.

Information

For local information; where to eat, activities, places to visit, please ask Kev or Del, visit our kiosk, or enquire at the Post Office where the friendly staff will be able to assist.

Items for guest use

Ask at the office for hire of boules, cricket sets, badminton, playing cards, puzzles and board games. Small deposit requested and returned after use.

Kiosk

The kiosk (situated in the office) stocks a small variety of essential grocery items; toiletries, milk and bread. For other supplies there is a family operated local grocery store in Mt Larcom.
